


The Online Registration- Advanced Certificate in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management Programme (ESBM) 2020-2021.

- The Online registration process is ongoing for the ESBM Programme.
- An online registration link (<https://reginfo.ou.ac.lk/>) is already sent to the students who applied for the Advanced Certificate in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management Programme.

- The students have to upload payment details and the verification documents for the registration process according to the instructions given in the link, before the deadline 3rd July 2020.
- Eligibility for Admission to the Advanced Certificate in Entrepreneurship and Small Business Management Programme is based on following qualifications, of which the student must provide evidence by uploading scanned documents for the verification for the registration process.

A person seeking admission to the ESBM programme shall be required to have,

- Passed six subjects including Mathematics and First Language with at least two Credit Passes at the Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination, Sri Lanka, **or**,
- Completed any Certificate Programme with 30 credits at Level 01 or above conducted by the Open University of Sri Lanka, **or**,
- Obtained a qualification at NVQF Level 3 or above acceptable to the Senate, **or**,
- an equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate.
