Who is this programme for?

- If you are seeking a formal qualification in literary studies
- If you teach literature but have limited formal training
- If you are seeking a deeper, richer engagement with literature, critical literary reading, literary theory and the theory and practice of teaching literature

Note: Students may opt to exit the programme with a Postgraduate Diploma in TLSC.

Entry Requirements

<i>Qualification</i>	<i>Experience</i>
Four (04) years' Bachelor's degree in English or English Language Teaching	[not required]
A three (03) year Bachelor's degree in Arts with English as a subject	A minimum of two (02) years' experience in English Literature or Language teaching
A three (03) year Bachelor's degree in the English medium	A minimum of three (03) years' experience in teaching English Literature at G.C.E. O/L or A/L or equivalent standard at a recognized institution
An equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate of the Open University of Sri Lanka	Relevant teaching experience

In addition to the above qualifications, applicants with extensive teaching experience and qualifications recognized by the Sri Lanka Qualifications Framework (SLQF) equivalent to those specified above will be considered.

Entry into the programme: Successful performance at the Selection Test

All applicants must sit the Selection Test. Further details about the Selection Test will be communicated in due course.
