

Amendment to the Election Notice

Faculty Student Union Elections 2018

The Election Notice dated 11th July 2018 is hereby amended as follows.

- **Eligibility to stand for election**

To be eligible for nomination to be elected as a member of a Faculty Student Union or as a Student Representative to a Faculty Board, a candidate should

(i) have completed 24 OUSL credits or 20 SLQF credits or 1/3rd of the programme of study for which he/she is currently registered, whichever is less

and

(ii) have registered for at least 18 OUSL credits or 15 SLQF credits in such a programme of study in the academic year in which he/she is standing for election as a member of a Faculty Student Union or as a Student Representative to a Faculty Board. Provided however, that where a candidate is in the final year of the programme of study and has less than 18 OUSL credits or 15 SLQF credits left to complete such programme of study he/she shall register for all the remaining credits required to complete such programme of study.

- **Eligibility to vote**

To be eligible to vote at an election for members of a Faculty Student Union and the Student Representatives to a Faculty Board, a student shall have registered in a programme of study in Levels 3 or above for a minimum of 9 OUSL credits or 8 SLQF credits.

Further note that the way of keeping vacant position when there are no female candidates have been nominated for the election, is as follows

(i) one from the Regional Centre where highest number of students registered in undergraduate programmes

(ii) other three are from Regional Centres with lowest number of students registered for whom representatives have been allocated

- **Election Dates**

Election dates should be changed as 09 consecutive days from **01st of September to 9th of September 2018.**
